CHECKLIST

- Transcripts from high school and/or college, trade or vocational technical school (up-to-date, unofficial transcripts may be submitted with this application).
- Personal data narrative, not to exceed two double-spaced pages, which includes:
 - a. Personal history,
 - b. Description of your career goals and how you plan to achieve them,
 - c. How you plan to contribute to the betterment of your community upon completion of your education.
- List by year for the last four years, your activities in:
 - a. Employment
 - b. Community service (include cumulative hours)
 - c. Extracurricular activities
- A complete application will include at least one letter of reference from each of the following: (Signed and dated on Jan. 1, 2009 or later; please identify the category on each letter):
 - a. Academic/School
 - b. Work/Volunteer
 - c. Personal/Character Reference
- Complete Financial Plan (must balance).
